Teahouse/Lodge Trek



Full Board Camping Trek

This is classic style of trekking in the remote areas of Nepal. Accommodation in luxury tents, dining tent with camping tables and stools and comfortable sleeping pads/ mattresses are provided. Western and Nepalese style of food is freshly prepared and served during the trek.

Jungle Safari in Nepal

The high Himalaya makes up Nepal's northern border and the southern lowland (Terai) is covered with dense tropical forests abundant in diverse wildlife and exotic birds. We organize the most exciting safari trips for individuals and groups especially in Chitwan, Bardia National Parks and Koshi Tappu Wildlife Reserve providing accommodations, transportations, meals and accompanying guides. Our itineraries include elephant safari, bird watching, jungle walks and canoeing etc.



River Rafting in Nepal

It is extremely popular, exciting yet safe adventure sport with many staircase rapids that challenge the body and spirit of the river runners. Very few places in the world can match the thundering course of the rivers of Nepal originating from the snow meltdown of the Himalayan terrain. We offer all levels of rafting excitement with rapids ranging from grade III to VI.



Paragliding

It is relatively a new adventure activity in Nepal for those who want to experience flying over villages, monasteries, temples, lakes and jungles like the Himalayan griffin vultures, eagles and kites in the sky. Paragliding provides an opportunity to observe life and nature from the new perspective. Pokhara has been internationally recognized destination for paragliding.



Ultralight Aircraft

This is an ideal way to do sightseeing tour of the Pokhara valley. One could fly like birds over the verdant hills, winding rivers and shining Phewa lake. The flights operate from sunrise to 11 a.m. and from 3 p.m. to sunset every day throughout the year except monsoon.



Mountain Flight

One of the best ways to get close to the Himalayas and to Everest in particular, is to take a mountain flight. It lasts for an hour offering an incredible close-up view of the awesome Himalayan peaks. We operate breathtaking mountain flights round the year, ensuring a window seat for all.



Bungee Jump

Nepal offers the third highest Bungee Jump in the world. The jump is a -160 meter drop from the platform into the gorge of the roaring river Bhote Koshi situated near the Nepal-Tibet border. This exciting sport is designed and introduced by one of New Zealand's leading Bungee consultants.



Mountain Biking

It offers an environmentally sound way of exploring the magnificent countryside, its landscape and living heritage. There are plenty of dirt roads and trails in Nepal to meet every mountain biker's wildest fantasy.

Volunteering in Nepal


